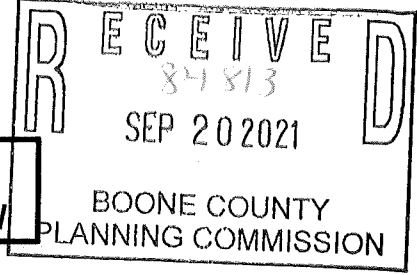

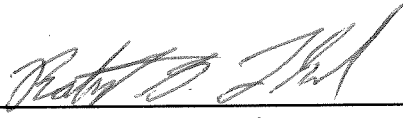

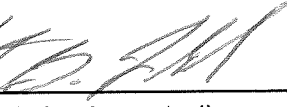

PROPOSAL

- A. A variance reducing the front yard setback from forty-eight (48) feet to twenty (20) feet.

SITE HISTORY

- 1969-
1974 Based on information contained in the Boone County GIS, the site was initially developed.
- 2002-
2004 Based on information contained in the Boone County GIS, a garage addition was constructed.
- 2021 On April 14, 2021, the Boone Board of Adjustment approved a variance reducing the width of a driveway aisle from twenty (20) feet to fifteen (15) feet, subject to the following conditions: (1) prior to construction, a Major Site Plan shall be submitted to the Boone County Planning Commission for review and approval; and (2) the proposed access driveway, having a minimum width of fifteen (15) feet, shall be entirely located within the existing ingress/egress easement.

APPLICABLE REGULATIONS

- A. Section 250 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations states that one of the duties of the Board of Adjustment is to hear and decide on applications for variances.
- B. Section 250 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations defines a variance as a departure from dimensional terms of the zoning regulation pertaining to the height, width, or location of structures, and the size of yards and open spaces where such departure meets the requirements of KRS 100.241 to 100.247.
- C. The Board should evaluate the request as it relates to the criteria necessary for granting a Variance as stated in Section 251 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations.
1. Findings listed in Section 251:
 - a. Before any variance is granted, the Board must find that the granting of the variance will not adversely affect the public health, safety or welfare, will not alter the essential character of the general vicinity, will not cause a hazard or a nuisance to the public, and will not allow an unreasonable circumvention of the requirements of the zoning regulations. In making

these findings, the board shall consider whether:

- (1) The requested variance arises from special circumstances which do not generally apply to land in the general vicinity, or in the same zone;
- (2) The strict application of the provisions of the regulations would deprive the applicant of the reasonable use of the land or would create an unnecessary hardship on the applicant;
- (3) The circumstances are the result of actions of the applicant taken subsequent to the adoption of the zoning regulation from which relief is sought.

- b. The Board shall deny any request for a variance arising from circumstances that are the result of willful violations of the zoning regulation by the applicant subsequent to the adoption of the zoning regulation from which relief is sought.

- D. Section 940 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations states that the "purpose of the Suburban Residential Two district is to provide a more compact, but essentially single family residential environment. Such districts will be located on suitable lands within established or proposed urban entities where adequate infrastructure facilities and services are available or proposed."
- E. Section 2000 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations states that the intent of the Small Community Overlay District "is to provide for the maintenance and development of small community centers where an integrated variety of land uses are essential to the vitality, viability, and well-being of the community. These circumstances are most prevalent in the many small, traditional community centers and town sites of Boone County, and may be appropriate to meet the needs of new community development in the County as well. The integration and variety of land uses found in small community centers often cannot practically be accommodated by the other basic zoning districts established by this order. This article creates an overlay district which may be established in areas appropriate for use as small community centers."
- F. Section 2010.1 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations state that all principally permitted uses of the basic underlying district are principally permitted uses within the SC district. Section 941.3 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations identify duplex dwelling units with garages as a principally permitted use within the SR-2 district.
- G. Section 4000 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations defines a duplex dwelling unit as a single residential structure that contains two dwelling units for use by two separate families living independent of each other. The two dwelling units within a duplex dwelling unit structure are separated by a common wall, floor, and/or ceiling.

- H. Section 2015 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations states that the required front yard setback shall conform to the setbacks of adjacent principal structures on the same, respective street frontage. The front yard setback of the adjacent principal structure, located at 3035 Torrid Street, is forty-eight (48) feet.

RELATIONSHIP TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

- A. The Our Boone County Plan 2040 Future Land Use Plan designates the site in question as “Suburban Density Residential”, which is defined as single family housing of up to four units per acre.
- B. The following Our Boone County Plan 2040 Goals and Objectives apply to this application:

Land uses and zoning decisions shall strive to balance the rights of landowners with the rights of neighbors and the community (Overall Goal A, Objective 4).

Development policies shall not discriminate against any person (Demographics Goal A, Objective 1).

Provide appropriate services, housing, employment, and shopping opportunities in order to meet the needs of the population in all geographic areas of the County (Demographics Goal A, Objective 4).

A broad range of housing opportunities shall be provided to meet the needs and desires of all household types and shall be balanced with affordability, employment centers, commercial areas, and educational needs (Demographics Goal B, Objective 1).

Residential developments shall be evaluated for impact on infrastructure, environment, health and safety considerations, buffering, and design with secondary consideration given to dwelling unit type and density (Demographics Goal B, Objective 4).

Residential developments shall be encouraged to plan and build in a manner compatible with the general housing density and design planned for the area, with the existing conditions of the site, and significant site features (Demographics Goal B, Objective 8).

- C. Torrid Street is a county maintained local street providing for two way traffic. There are no sidewalks along the roadway.

SURROUNDING LAND USES AND ZONING

- North: Single-family residential and Burlington Pentecostal Church (SR-2/SC)
- South: Single-family residential (SR-2/SC)
- East: Single-family residential (SR-2/SC)

West: Single-family residential (SR-2/SC)

SITE CHARACTERISTICS

- A. The 0.535 acre property is located approximately 150 feet south of Torrid Street and approximately 250 feet west of Elwood Avenue.
- B. The site is currently occupied by an approximate 2,100 square foot single-family residential dwelling and an approximate 1,900 square foot detached garage/accessory structure.
- C. Access to the site is via an approximate nine (9) foot wide driveway that is partially located within a fifteen (15) foot wide ingress/egress easement.
- D. The site slopes downward from east to west, at an average grade of 5%.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT

- A. Demolition and removal of the existing dwelling and the existing garage/accessory structure.
- B. Construction of two (2) duplex dwelling units.
- C. Provision for eight (8) parking spaces.
- D. Access via a fifteen (15) foot wide driveway.

STAFF COMMENTS

- A. The existing dwelling on the site has a front yard setback of approximately thirty (30) feet. If the setback variance is approved, there will be a separation of approximately 160 feet between the dwellings on the site and the nearest building to the north of the site.
- B. There is extensive existing vegetation located on the adjacent properties to the north, east, and west of the site in question.
- C. Should the Board take action to approve the submitted request, the following condition should be considered as part of that action:
 - 1. Prior to construction, a Major Site Plan shall be submitted to the Boone County Planning Commission for review and approval.

CONCLUSION

- A. KRS 100.241 and Section 220 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations give the Boone County Board of Adjustment and Zoning Appeals the authority to act on the request.

- B. Section 251 of the Boone County Zoning Regulations identifies criteria necessary for granting a Variance. The applicant needs to provide information as to how their application meets this criteria.

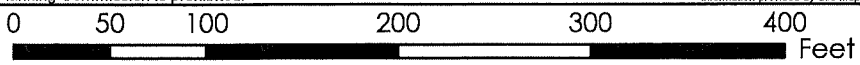

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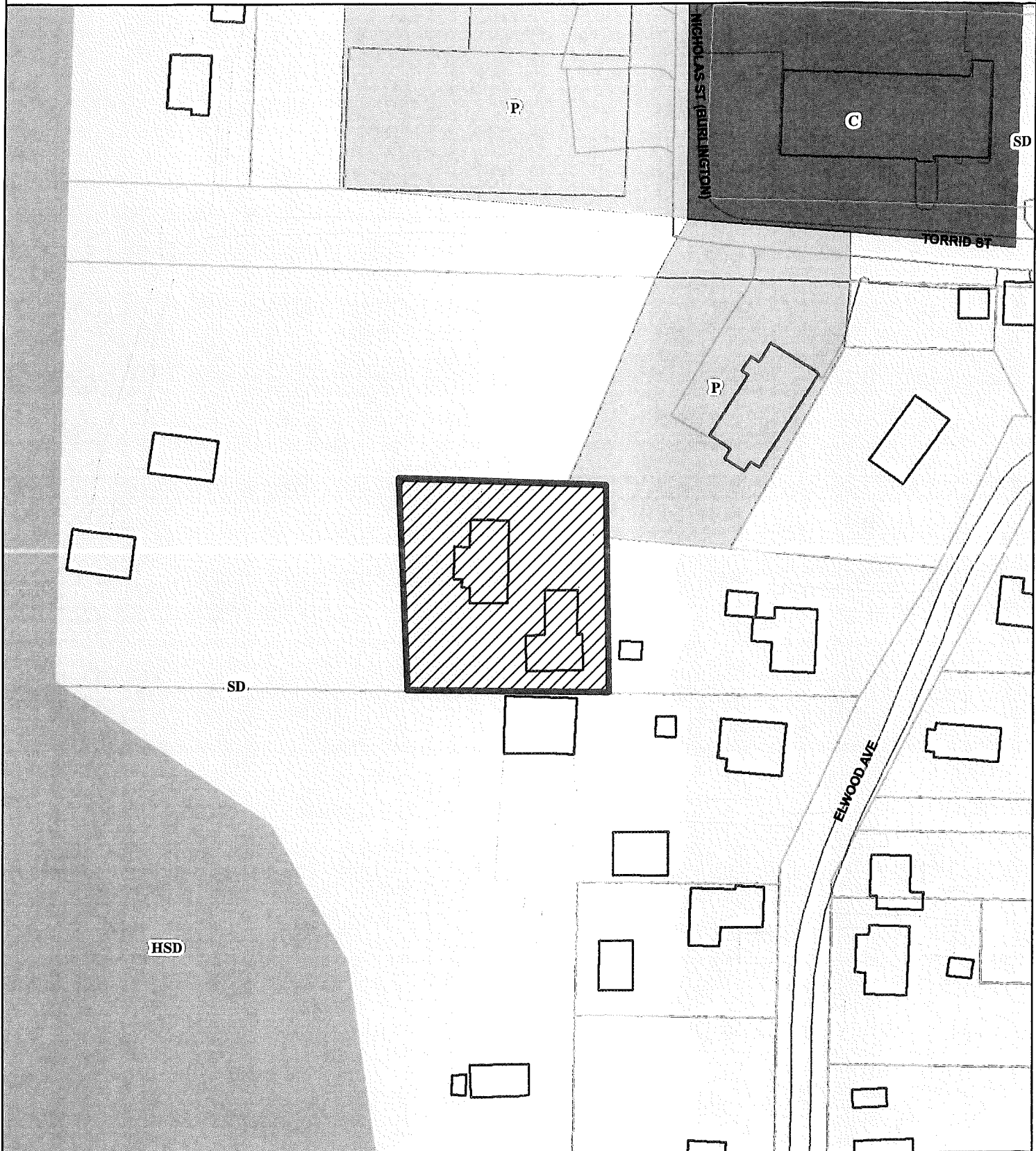

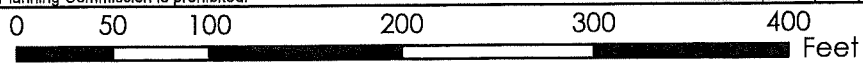
2040 Future Land Use Map
