ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF FLORENCE, BOONE COUNTY, KENTUCKY, SAID TERRITORY BEING CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT CITY LIMITS ON NORTHEAST.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Florence, Kentucky does ordain as follows:

SECTION I

The following described territory being contiguous to the City of Florence, Boone County, Kentucky on the Northeast is hereby annexed to the City of Florence, Kentucky:

Beginning at the intersection of the Boone-Kenton County line and the present Corporation line of the City of Florence in Kenta-Boo Drive;

thence,
 Southwestwardly with present City line parallel to Virginia Avenue 350 feet, more or less, to West line of Lexington Avenue; thence,
 Southwardly with West line of Lexington Avenue and with present City line 244 feet to a corner; thence,
 Southwestwardly with present city line 740 feet, more or less, to the Bustetter line; thence,
 With Bustetter and present City limits N 41.15°W 135 feet, more or less; thence,
 N 30° E with present City limits 229 feet to a point in the Monte Vista Subdivision rear line; thence,
 Northwestwardly with present city line and Monta Vista Subdivision 454 feet, more or less; thence,
 S 31° E 525 feet with present City line and Bustetter tract; thence,
 S 34° 30' E, 1030 feet, more or less, with present City line; thence,
 Southwestwardly with present City line 1140 feet, more or less; thence,
 Northwardly 850 feet, more or less to Southeast corner of L. T. Utz Subdivision; thence,
 Northwestwardly with line of L. T. Utz Subdivision also a present City line, 335 feet to a point; thence,
 N 70° W with present City limits 162 feet; thence,
 Southwestwardly with present City line 1280 feet, more or less, to Price Pike; thence,
 N 22° E with present City line and Daugherty and Taylor Subdivision 270 feet; thence,
 N 10° W with present City line and parallel to Price Pike 670 feet, more or less; thence,
 N 30° W with present City Line 200 feet to center of Price Pike; thence,
 N 10° W with center of Price Pike 285 feet; thence,
 N 26° W with Price Pike 145 feet; thence,
 N 48° 22' E, 1115 feet to a point; thence,
 N 48° 57' E 1491 feet on a line between Scott and the Kenta-Boo Subdivision; thence,
 N 38° 48' W with Scott lands 937 feet; thence,
 N 51° 12' E with Scott lands 1447 feet; thence,
 N 42° 18' E 618 feet; thence,
 N 64° 12' E 1000 feet; thence,
 N 57° 40' E 350 feet, more or less, to a point in the Boone-Kenton County line; thence,
 S 5° 30' E with the Boone-Kenton County line 3830 feet, more or less, to place of Beginning.

It being the intention to annex all lands between present City limits on the North East to the County line and Northwardly to the lines running between Price Pike and the said County line in Dry Creek.

SECTION II

All ordinances and/or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, adoption and publication according to law.
