

ORDINANCE NO. 77-002

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE ANNEXATION TO AND MAKING A PART OF THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY AND LYING TO THE NORTH AND EAST THEREOF:

The Board of Trustees of the City of Union does ordain as follows:

SECTION I

There is hereby proposed that the following described, unincorporated territory lying to the north and east of the present city limits of the City of Union, Kentucky and contiguous thereto shall be annexed to and made a part of the corporate territory of the City of Union, Kentucky. The territory is described more specifically as follows:

Located generally in Boone County, Kentucky, northeast of and abutting on the present city lines of the City of Union and described thus; BEGINNING at the most northerly corner of the City of Union on U.S. Highway 42, which said corner is S 35 E. 30 feet from the southeast corner of the original Jones service station building; thence in a northeasterly direction and running with the centerline of the pavement of U.S. Highway 42 a distance of 7,200 feet or sufficient to reach its intersection with the centerline of the Gunpowder Road at Sugartit; thence in a southeasterly direction and running with the centerline of said Gunpowder Road a distance of 8,300 feet or sufficient to reach its intersection with the centerline of the Mt. Zion Road; thence in a southwesterly direction along the centerline of said Mt. Zion Road a distance of 4,150 feet or sufficient to reach the most easterly corner of the City of Union on said road; thence continuing along said road S. 66-30 W. 250 feet to another corner in said city limits; thence leaving said road and running with lines of the City of Union, N 4-30 E 300 feet, S. 81-45 W. 750 feet; thence in a northwesterly direction with lines of the City of Union and Anderland Subdivision 1,300 feet; thence with said cityline in a southwesterly direction 210 feet to a point on the southeast line of the original incorporation boundary of said city;

thence therewith N 31-55 E. 1,440 feet to the most easterly corner thereof; thence with the northeast line of said city N. 58-5 W. 5,280 feet to the place of beginning containing 900 acres or 1.42 square miles.

SECTION II


A resident or freeholder of the unincorporated territory which the City proposes to annex may within thirty (30) days from the date of enactment of this Ordinance proposing to annex the aforesaid territory protest or remonstrate against the action of the City by filing suit or petition in the Boone Circuit Court for Boone County, Kentucky.

SECTION III

In the event that no protest or remonstrance suit is filed by a resident or freeholder of the unincorporated territory proposed to be annexed by this Ordinance, the Board of Trustees for the City of Union, Kentucky proposes to enact an Ordinance effectuating the annexation of the above described, unincorporated territory into the corporate limits of the City of Union, Kentucky.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance proposing the annexation of the above described territory shall be published twice in the Boone County Recorder.

ORDINANCE NO. 77-002

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING THE ANNEXATION TO AND MAKING A PART OF THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY AND LYING TO THE NORTH AND EAST THEREOF:

The Board of Trustees of the City of Union does ordain as follows:

SECTION I

There is hereby proposed that the following described, unincorporated territory lying to the north and east of the present city limits of the City of Union, Kentucky and contiguous thereto shall be annexed to and made a part of the corporate territory of the City of Union, Kentucky. The territory is described more specifically as follows:

Located generally in Boone County, Kentucky, northeast of and abutting on the present city lines of the City of Union and described thus; BEGINNING at the most northerly corner of the City of Union on U.S. Highway 42, which said corner is S 35 E. 30 feet from the southeast corner of the original Jones service station building; thence in a northeasterly direction and running with the centerline of the pavement of U.S. Highway 42 a distance of 7,200 feet or sufficient to reach its intersection with the centerline of the Gunpowder Road at Sugartit; thence in a southeasterly direction and running with the centerline of said Gunpowder Road a distance of 8,300 feet or sufficient to reach its intersection with the centerline of the Mt. Zion Road; thence in a southwesterly direction along the centerline of said Mt. Zion Road a distance of 4,150 feet or sufficient to reach the most easterly corner of the City of Union on said road; thence continuing along said road S. 66-30 W. 250 feet to another corner in said city limits; thence leaving said road and running with lines of the City of Union, N 4-30 E 300 feet, S. 81-45 W. 750 feet; thence in a northwesterly direction with lines of the City of Union and Anderland Subdivision 1,300 feet; thence with said city line in a southwesterly direction 210 feet to a point on the southeast line of the original incorporation boundary of said city; thence therewith N 31-55 E. 1,440 feet to the most easterly corner thereof; thence with the northeast line of said city N. 58-5 W. 5,280 feet to the place of beginning containing 900 acres or 1.42 square miles.

SECTION II

A resident or freeholder of the unincorporated territory which the City proposes to annex may within thirty (30) days from the date of enactment of this Ordinance proposing to annex the aforesaid territory protest or remonstrate against the action of the City by filing suit or petition in the Boone Circuit Court for Boone County, Kentucky.

SECTION III

In the event that no protest or remonstrance suit is filed by a resident or freeholder of the unincorporated territory proposed to be annexed by this Ordinance, the Board of Trustees for the City of Union, Kentucky proposes to enact an Ordinance effectuating the annexation of the above described, unincorporated territory into the corporate limits of the City of Union, Kentucky.

SECTION IV

This Ordinance proposing the annexation of the above described territory shall be published twice in the Boone County Recorder.
