

ORDINANCE NO. 84-008

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AN AREA WITHIN THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY, CONTAINING 3.9 SQUARE MILES TO BE STRICKEN FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS THEREOF AND THEREBY REDUCING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF UNION.

WHEREAS, KRS 81A.440 provides for a means whereby a City may reduce its boundaries, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Union, by Ordinance No. 84-003 stated the City's intention to place before the duly qualified voters of that portion of the City of Union to be de-annexed the question of whether the hereinafter described area containing 3.9 square miles should remain a part of the City of Union or be de-annexed therefrom, and;

WHEREAS, said issue was placed upon the ballot at the regular election held on November 6, 1984, and;

WHEREAS, a majority of those qualified voters voting on the question voted "Yes" on the question of the area being stricken from the boundaries of the City of Union, and;

WHEREAS, the result of said election was duly certified by the Boone County Clerk on the 14th day of November, 1984; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Union, Kentucky:

Section 1. It is hereby declared that the following described area heretofore lying within the corporate limits of the City of Union, Kentucky, is hereby declared to be stricken from the corporate limits of the City of Union, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in Hathaway Road, a/k/a The Union-Big Bone Road a/k/a Kentucky Highway 536 at a point in the North right-of-way line thereof and where the boundary of the City of Union prior to April 15, 1980 intersects; thence

1. N 58-5 W 2800 feet with said city line,
2. N 31-55 E 5000 feet more or less with said city line to the South line of the South entrance to Fowlers Creek Road,
3. In a Northwesterly direction 325 feet more or less with the South line of said entrance to the South line of the North entrance.
4. In a Northerly direction 2800 feet more or less with the South line of Fowlers Creek Road to the South line of Longbranch Road,

5. In a Westerly direction 11,200 feet more or less with the South line of Longbranch Road to the East line of Camp Ernst Road,
6. In a Southerly direction 10,000 feet more or less with the East line of Camp Ernst Road to the North right-of-way of Kentucky Highway #536 (The Union-Big Bone Road),
7. In a Easterly direction therewith 12,600 feet or sufficient to reach the place of beginning containing 3.9 square miles.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption and publication as required by law pursuant to KRS 424.130(1)(a).


Section 3. Introduced, seconded and given first reading on the 21st day of November, 1984, at a special meeting of the City Commission of Union, Kentucky.

Section 4. Adopted by the City Commission of the City of Union, Kentucky, after second reading at a special meeting on the 23rd day of November, 1984, and on the same occasion signed in open session by the Mayor evidenced by his approval, attested under seal by the City Clerk of the City of Union, Kentucky, and declared to be in full force and effect.
