

**CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY
ORDINANCE NO. 2007- 005**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SPEED LIMIT ON THE DEDICATED
STREETS OF THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY AT TWENTY (20) MILES
PER HOUR**

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.R.S. 189.390, the City of Union, Kentucky is authorized to establish speed limits on any city street within its jurisdictional boundaries;

WHEREAS, the speed limit on the dedicated streets located in Union, Kentucky is currently posted at various speed limits from twenty (20) miles per hour to forty-five (45) miles per hour, with some of the posted speed limits not being authorized by the City Commission of the City of Union, Kentucky

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the safety and well-being of the citizens of the City of Union, Kentucky that the City Commission set a speed limit for all of the dedicated city streets;

WHEREAS, all streets within the city limits of Union, Kentucky shall be twenty (20) miles per hour, unless the City Commission, by separate Ordinance, sets a different posted speed limit. Further, the City Engineer is authorized to post twenty (20) mile per hour speed limit signs indicating all streets are posted at twenty (20) miles per hour, unless otherwise posted.

***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
THE CITY OF UNION, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:***

SECTION I

That the speed limit on all residential streets, and all future dedicated streets, shall be posted at twenty (20) miles per hour unless the City Commission, by prior Ordinance or future Ordinance, specifically sets a different speed limit for a particular street.


SECTION II

The penalties for speeding on said roadways shall be in accordance with the Uniform Statute as set forth in K.R.S. 189.394.
