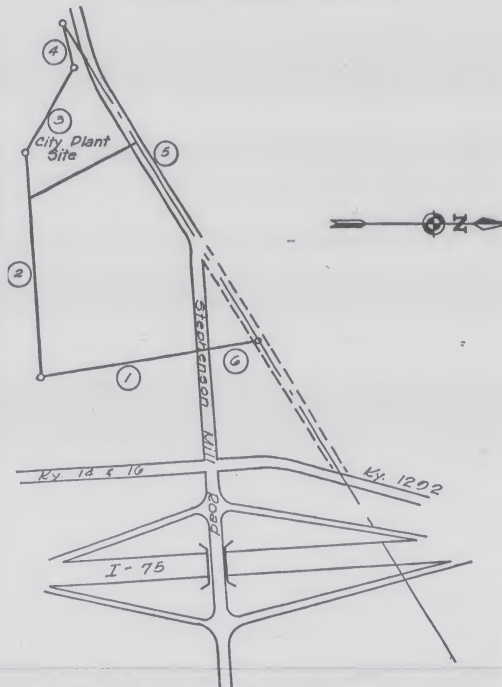

**ORDINANCE NO. 1973 — 12**



lying to the West of and being contiguous to the present corporate limits of the City of Walton, Kentucky, be annexed to and made a part of the corporate territory of the City of Walton, Kentucky.

Section 2. Said territory hereby annexed is bounded and described as follows, to wit:

Being contiguous to the existing Westerly City Limits of the City of Walton, Kentucky proposes to annex the following described land:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of relocated Stephenson Mill Road said point being in the existing City Limits; thence with the existing City Limits; thence (1) S 8-24-30 E 790.0 feet; thence (2) S83-50-30 W 1088.59 feet; thence (3) N 60-09-30 W 485.10 feet; thence (4) S 76-20-30 W 165.00 feet; thence (5) N 57-10-30 E 1793.1 feet; thence (6) S 8-24-30 E 286.6 feet to the beginning.

The plat of the above described territory is incorporated herein by reference, and is appended hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held by a proper court to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses, it being expressly declared that the remainder of said ordinance would have been passed despite such invalidity.

PASSED AND APPROVED ON FIRST READING, this the 9th day of October, 1973, by a vote of 6 members of the City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky.

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO AND MAKING A PART OF THE INCORPORATED TERRITORY OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY, (A fifth class city), CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY CONTIGUOUS TO THE EXISTING WESTERLY CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky, deems it to be in the best interests of its citizens and for the best interests of persons residing in certain unincorporated territory, said territory being contiguous to the present City Limits on the Westerly corporate limits of the City of Walton, Kentucky, that said territory be annexed to and become a part of the corporate territory of the City of Walton, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Walton, Kentucky, has properly passed Ordinance No. 1973-7A, which ordinance proposed to annex said territory and said ordinance having been published once a week for four (4) consecutive weeks in the Walton Advertiser, and no protest suit having been filed against said annexation, as by law required,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WALTON, KENTUCKY:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described unincorporated territory

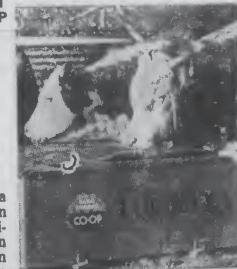
