

ORDINANCE NO. 0-8-77

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING ALL OF A PUBLIC WAY CONSISTING OF AN UN-NAMED ALLEY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AND AUTHORIZING, ORDERING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE THE NECESSARY COURT ACTION TO HAVE SAME CLOSED.

WHEREAS, a certain public way consisting of an un-named alley in the City of Florence, Kentucky is not being used and has never been paved, and is in such a position as to indicate that it will not be needed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the owners of all the land adjacent thereto, have petitioned this Council to take the necessary legal steps to have same closed as a public way and have agreed to pay the cost of said closing.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That a certain public way consisting of an un-named alley described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the right-of-way of Goodridge Drive, the southeast corner of Lot #13, and being a corner with the north right-of-way of a 10 foot alley; thence with said alley S 57 - 41 W 370.0 feet; thence N 40 W 67.0 feet; thence S 60 - 04 W 10.15 feet; thence S 40 E 79.14 feet; thence N 57 - 41 E 370.0 feet to the right-of-way of Goodridge Drive; thence N 32 W 10.0 feet to the beginning and being all of the alley between Lot #13 and #14 and that portion of the alley in the rear of Lot #13, Nonpariel Park Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 1, Page 50 of the Boone County Court Clerks Office at Burlington, Kentucky.

SECTION II

This ordinance is passed under and in compliance with KRS 95.360 and Raymond R. Vincent as City Attorney, he and he

is hereby authorized, ordered and directed to institute the necessary court action in the Boone Circuit Court to have all of the above named street or public way closed.

SECTION III

That all ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


SECTION IV
