

ORDINANCE NO. 0-2-90

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF PORTIONS OF A TEN FOOT ALLEY AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT OF NONPAREIL PARK SUBDIVISION IN THE VICINITY OF THE INTERSECTION OF GOODRIDGE DRIVE AND DIXIE HIGHWAY IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City of Florence, Kentucky, has been requested by the owners of the property abutting certain portions of an alley as shown on the Plat of Nonpareil Park Subdivision in the vicinity of the intersection of Goodridge Drive and Dixie Highway, which is in the City of Florence, Kentucky, to have same closed as a public way or alley of the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that such closing would be consistent with and in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Florence, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property abutting such portions of an alley described herein have agreed to consent to the legal measures necessary to close same as a public way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That a portion of a ten foot alley as shown on the Plat of Nonpareil Park Subdivision in the vicinity of the intersection of Goodridge Drive and Dixie Highway in the City of Florence, Kentucky, more particularly described in Exhibits "A" and "B" shall be and the same is hereby authorized to be closed as a public way or alley of the City.


SECTION II

That this Ordinance is enacted pursuant to K.R.S. 82.405 and other applicable law and the appropriate officials of the City of Florence, Kentucky, are hereby authorized and directed to take all legal steps necessary under Kentucky law for the closing of such alley as a public way as described and shown herein, on condition that the owners of all lots abutting said public way or public alley agree to said closing and to pay the costs thereof.


