TANK

Judge Ferguson recognized Mr. Robert Ronka of the Transportation Authority of Northern Kentucky (TANK) regarding a request of the fiscal court for additional studies regarding financial feasibility of extending bus service in Boone County.

Commissioner Robinson stated that he had requested at the previous meeting if any further study was done it should be done on a county wide basis.

Commissioner Raverty said that he would request that the study include the economic feasibility of routings particularly to the Burlington area where a route was tried early in the 1980's and came close to meeting the economic demands necessary. He said he would like to see a projection of the cost to the court as well as to the riders.

Commissioner Davis stated that he had also been in communication with Mr. Terry Salle, Walton City Council Member, regarding the feasibility of bus service to the Walton community. He said that, perhaps, if nothing else, a park and ride lot could be established in that end of the county.

Mr. Ronka, General Manager of TANK, stated that TANK is always willing to look at new park and ride sites.

Commissioner Raverty stated that he would like a written statement back from the Transportation Authority outlining specifically what would be done on behalf of the county and what could be expected in the report.

Mr. Ronka agreed that would not be a problem to present at a future meeting.

ALLEY CLOSING - BELLVIEW

Judge Ferguson recognized Mr. Doug Tomlinson, who requested the closure of an alley in the town of Bellview. Mr. Tomlinson requested that the easement between Lots 18 & 19 as platted in the town of Bellview be closed. He further stated that the alley between Lots 5 & 7 has already been closed in prior action of the court.

Commissioner Raverty moved approval of the motion to close the alley between Lots 18 & 19 in Bellview, seconded by Commissioner Robinson. Without objection, Judge Ferguson called for a vote on the motion, Commissioner Raverty voted AYE, Commissioner Robinson voted AYE, Commissioner Davis voted AYE, and Judge Ferguson's vote to reflect the will of the majority.

ORDINANCES & RESOLUTIONS.

RESOLUTION 08-88-01 - AVERITT EXPRESS

Judge Ferguson moved to Ordinances & Resolutions and presented Resolution 08-88-01, a resolution of the Boone County Fiscal Court for a zoning map amendment to the Boone County, Kentucky Zoning Map, such map amendment being a zone change from Commercial Services (C-3) to Industrial One (I-1) for a 15.65 acre site generally located on the west side of U.S. 25 (Dixie Highway) approximately 300 feet north of Frogtown Road, Boone County, Kentucky, being requested by Averitt Express (applicant) and being recommended for denial by the Boone County Planning & Zoning Commission via Resolution R-39-88.
