Having been given as required by Statute  
 Sec 178.050. K.S.A. That is, by notice duly  
 published by the County Road Supervisor  
 in the Boone County Recorder on July 23.  
 1964 and July 30. 1964, and by Notice  
 posted in three (3) Public places in the  
 vicinity of the Road; and the Court  
 having appointed C. L. Crapper and  
 Walter Brown as Viewers, and they  
 together with the County Road Supervisor,  
 having been duly instructed and sworn  
 entered upon the discharge of their duties  
 and thereafter returned a written Report  
 in open Court on the day set for the  
 hearing, to-wit August 4-1964, stating  
 in effect that no possible inconvenience  
 could result from the Closing of Alley  
 No. 7. That same had never been open to  
 Traffic and had not therefore served  
 as a convenience to the public at any  
 time, either past or present.

There having been no exception taken to  
 the petitioned request, and no appearance  
 against same, and it further appearing  
 to the Court from the report filed by  
 the Viewers, from the statements in the  
 petition filed and from the evidence of  
 Record as to the status of the Road, and  
 the Court now being advised it appears  
 that the petition filed should be granted.  
 Now therefore, it is ordered, adjudged and  
 directed by the Court; that the herein  
 after described road or alley be  
 permanently discontinued as a public  
 way, and that same be hence forth closed  
 to any public use, the same is fully described  
 as follows. To-wit.

Being located in what is known as the  
 Town of Burlington in Boone County,  
 Kentucky, as designated as

Plat of said Town and more particularly described as being laid out between Barrow Street and Orient Street, a distance of 431 feet, and passing between Lots 48 + 49 and also 69 + 70 and indicated as 25 ft in Width.

Said Plat being recorded in the County Court Clerk's office of Boone County, Kentucky in Plat Book #1 Page 112.
