BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT

Closing of Abandoned County Roads :

Upon being moved and duly approved this 5th day of
September, 1972,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Boone County Fiscal Court
that the following county roads and rights of way be permanently
closed:

1. Walton Road - BEGINNING at its intersection with
Kentucky Route 20 as originally located and running
northwest along its location approximately 2100 feet
to the intersection of the South line of the Inter-
state Highway #275.

2. Popham Hill Road - BEGINNING at its inter-
section with the South line of Kentucky State
Highway #20 as originally located, and running
Southeast along the location of said road approxi-
mately 3100 feet to the Northwest line of Youell
Road (Ky. Route 1334) as originally located.

Subject to easements and rights of the Union Light,
Heat & Power Company for utilities located within
the Popham Hill Road right of way.

3. Point Pleasant Road - BEGINNING at its inter-
section with Donaldson Road (Ky. Route 236) as
originally located and running Northeast along the
present location of said Point Pleasant Road to
the Donaldson Highway relocation.

4. Bellanca Road - (formerly a street in Skyway
Subdivision) - BEGINNING at its intersection with
Donaldson Road (Ky. Highway #236) as originally
located and running Northeast along the location
of Bellanca Road approximately 1250 feet to its
intersection with the Southwest line of Donaldson
Highway as relocated.

5. Mineola Road - BEGINNING at its intersection with Donaldson Road (Ky. Route 236) as originally located and running Northeast along the original location of Mineola Road to the relocation of Donaldson Highway.

6. The Old Andersons Ferry Road which lies on the Southwest side of and abutting the Rolling Green Acres Subdivision - BEGINNING at its intersection with the Point Pleasant Road and running Southeast along the location of said old Andersons Ferry Road approximately 500 feet.


Subject to existing easements and rights of way for any utilities located within the right of way.

The above roads are ordered to be permanently closed. All rights and upkeep to said roads and rights of way shall by this action be removed from public responsibility.
