

ORDINANCE NO. 312

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING A PORTION OF BUFFINGTON ROAD IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AND AUTHORIZING, ORDERING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE THE NECESSARY COURT ACTION TO HAVE SAME CLOSED.

WHEREAS, a portion of Buffington Road, beginning at its intersection with Industrial Road or Kentucky Highway No. 1829 and running generally northeastwardly to the Boone-Kenton County Line is not being used as a public way, and is in such a position that it will not be needed any longer as a public way of the City, and

WHEREAS, the Northern Kentucky Industrial Foundation, Inc. is the owner of all the land adjacent thereto and on both sides thereof, and has requested this Council to take the necessary steps to have same closed as a public way, and

WHEREAS, the Commonwealth of Kentucky is building a new industrial highway to serve generally the same area as was formerly served by Buffington Road, and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to close Buffington Road in order that new and/or expanded industrial facilities can be located in the Industrial Park now owned by the Northern Kentucky Industrial Foundation, Inc., and that same would be most beneficial to the general welfare of the citizens and residents of the City of Florence, Kentucky.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the portion of Buffington Road, beginning at its point of intersection with Industrial Road, also known as Kentucky Highway No. 1829, northeastwardly to its northeasterly terminus

and/or the Boone-Kenton County line be, and the same is hereby closed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky.

SECTION II

That this ordinance is passed in compliance with the provisions of KRS 94.360, and that Raymond R. Vincent as City Attorney be, and he is hereby authorized, ordered and directed to institute the necessary court action in the Boone Circuit Court to have same closed.

SECTION III

It is further hereby ordered that the entire costs of this procedure to close said portion of Buffington Road be done at the expense of the owner of the property abutting same, who has requested that this action be taken.

SECTION IV

That all ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION V

If any section, paragraph or clause of this ordinance be held by a proper court to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the remaining sections, paragraphs or clauses, it being hereby expressly declared that the remainder of this ordinance would have been passed despite such invalidity.
