

ORDINANCE NO. 0-4-90

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CLOSING OF A PORTION OF CAROLINE AVENUE AS A PUBLIC WAY IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Florence, Kentucky, has been requested by the owners of property abutting portions of Caroline Avenue as described herein, which is in the City of Florence, Kentucky, to have same closed as described as a public way in the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that such closing would be consistent with and in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Florence, Kentucky, and there is no benefit to continue to maintain this portion of Caroline Avenue as a public way in the City, and

WHEREAS, all owners of property abutting this portion of Caroline Avenue have agreed to consent to the legal measures necessary to close this public way at no cost to the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That a portion of Caroline Avenue in the City of Florence, Kentucky, more particularly described in Exhibit "A" shall be and the same is hereby authorized to be closed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky. It is understood that upon completing the procedure for closing this portion of Caroline Avenue as a public way in Florence, Kentucky, that the abutting property owners shall share equally that part of the public way closed.

SECTION II

This Ordinance is enacted in accordance with K.R.S. 82.405 and other applicable law and the appropriate officials of the City of Florence, Kentucky, are hereby authorized and directed to take all legal steps necessary under Kentucky law for the closing of this public way as described herein and in Exhibit "A". This Ordinance and the closing of Caroline Avenue as authorized herein is subject to and conditioned upon owners of

all property abutting that portion of Caroline Avenue described herein agreeing to the closing and to pay the costs thereof, with no cost to be paid by the City.
