

ORDINANCE NO. 232

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSING AND VACATION OF THAT SECTION OF CIRCLE DRIVE KNOWN AND DESIGNATED AS THE CIRCLE AT THE WESTERLY END OF SAID STREET, IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, BOONE COUNTY, KENTUCKY; AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND EXTENSION OF CIRCLE DRIVE THROUGH SAID CIRCLE TO THE WESTERLY PORTION THEREOF; AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO BRING AN ACTION IN THE BOONE CIRCUIT COURT TO EFFECT SUCH CLOSING AND VACATION IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATUTES MADE AND PROVIDED THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, in the dedication of Circle Drive a section known as the Circle having a diameter of approximately fifty (50) feet was laid out and designated as a reserved area at the westerly end of Circle Drive, and that said Circle has served no useful purpose but in its present condition prevents the extension of Circle Drive to the lands immediately to the west thereof, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the owners of the land immediately to the west of said Circle Drive to subdivide and develop said land, providing access can be had to Circle Drive, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Florence deem it advisable and necessary that said section of Circle Drive known as the Circle in the westerly end of Circle Drive be closed and vacated as a Circle and that a street be laid out and dedicated continuing from Circle Drive through said Circle to the land immediately to the west thereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE:

SECTION I.

That that portion of Circle Drive known as the Circle at the westerly end of said Circle Drive in the City of Florence, Boone County, Kentucky, be closed and vacated as a Circle and that Circle Drive continue through said Circle as a duly dedicated street to the lands immediately to the west thereof.

SECTION II.

That the City Attorney be and he is hereby authorized and directed to bring a proper action in the Boone Circuit Court to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION III.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law, and all ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.
