

ORDINANCE NO. 0-11-82

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLOSING OF A PORTION OF CURTIS AVENUE, A PUBLIC WAY IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY, AND AUTHORIZING THOSE OTHER MEASURES NECESSARY TO LEGALLY CLOSE SAID PUBLIC WAY.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of Florence, Kentucky has been requested by all owners of property in or abutting a portion of Curtis Avenue, a public way in the City of Florence, Kentucky to have said portion closed, and

WHEREAS, the Common Council has determined that such closing would be consistent with and pursuant to the public health and welfare, and

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property in or abutting that portion of Curtis Avenue to be closed have agreed to consent to the legal measures necessary to close said public way and have agreed to pay the costs of such closing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That portion of Curtis Avenue, a public way in the City of Florence, Kentucky, as more particularly described on Exhibit "A" shall be and the same is hereby closed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky. Exhibit "A", which is the description of that portion of Curtis Avenue to be closed by this Ordinance is incorporated into this Ordinance as if fully set out.

SECTION II

That this Ordinance is enacted in conformance with provisions of KRS 82.405 and other applicable law, and the appropriate officials of the City of Florence, Kentucky are hereby authorized and directed to take those legal measures

required under Kentucky law for the closing of that portion of Curtis Avenue as a public way as authorized herein, provided all owners of property in or abutting that portion of Curtis Avenue to be closed by this Ordinance agree to said closing and to pay the costs incurred.
