

# Resolution Of The Boone County Fiscal Court

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT APPROVING THE RIGHT-OF-WAY VACATION OF FIFTH STREET (BELLEVIEW) BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND SYCAMORE STREET AS RECOMMENDED BY THE VIEWING COMMITTEE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT:**

## SECTION I

**That Boone County Fiscal Court hereby grants the right-of-way vacation of Fifth Street (Bellevue) between Main Street and Sycamore Street per the following conditions:**

- 1. The right-of-ways are vacated to the adjoining parcels.**
- 2. The right-of-ways are surveyed with conveyance plats and deeds prepared for each portion of the vacation.**
- 3. There shall be a permanent utility easement placed over the vacated right-of-ways, unless releases are obtained from all applicable utility companies.**
- 4. The owners of the adjoining parcels shall be responsible for each plat and deed preparation.**
- 5. The plats and deeds shall be reviewed by the Boone County Attorney and the Boone County Engineer.**

## SECTION II

**That this Resolution is hereby approved and adopted in Open Session of the Boone County Fiscal Court this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2000.**
