

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING FRANCIS COURT IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AS A PUBLIC WAY AND AUTHORIZING, ORDERING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE THE NECESSARY COURT ACTION TO AND SAME CLOSED AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

WHEREAS, Francis Court as shown on the plat of Erlanger Heights Subdivision adjoining lots 9-17 and 19-22 and being in block 25 of said subdivision is not now being used and has never been paved and is located in such a position as to indicate that it will not be needed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the owner of all the land adjacent to said street and produced this council to take the necessary legal steps to have same closed as a public way and have agreed to pay the cost of said closing.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

That Francis Court as shown on the plat of Erlanger Heights Subdivision adjoining lots 9-17 and 19-22 of block 25 of said subdivision be and the same is hereby closed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky.

Section II

This ordinance is passed under and in compliance with KRS 94.360 and Raymond R. Vincent as City Attorney is hereby authorized, ordered, and directed to institute the necessary civil action in the Boone Circuit Court to for said street closing.

Section III

That all ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby appealed.


Section IV
