

BOONE FISCAL COURT

IN RE THE DISCONTINUING OF A  
PORTION OF HARVEST LANE


O R D E R

On the petition of Thomas Middendorf, through his attorney, Robert F. Greene, seeking to discontinue that portion described below of Harvest Lane which divides or is contiguous to his property under the provisions of KRS 178.070; there having been a public hearing on the petition as required by law; and the viewers appointed by the Court having reported that no inconvenience to the general public would result from discontinuing said road; and the Court being advised that the said road is not a post road and that said road is not maintained by the county; and the Court being fully advised in all the premises,

IT IS ORDERED that a portion of Harvest Lane which is described as follows be and hereby is closed as a public highway:

BEGINNING at a point in the westerly line of Harvest Lane, 35 feet south of the common corner of Lots #1 and 2, of Edwood Subdivision; thence S 13-31 E, along the westerly line of Harvest Lane, a distance of 215.0 feet to the southerly line of Edwood Subdivision ; thence N 75-15 E along the said southerly line of Edwood Subdivision, a distance of 50 feet to the easterly line of Harvest Lane; thence N 13-31 W along the easterly line of Harvest Lane, a distance of 214.58 feet; thence S 75-15 W, a distance of 50.00 feet to the place of beginning.
