ORDER

IN RE: ABANDONED COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY


IN HIGHLAND ACRES SUBDIVISION

It is hereby ordered by the Boone County Fiscal Court, in their regular January term, that the abandoned and unused County Road, which is fully described below:

Located generally in Groups #409, #410 and #411 of the Highland Acres Subdivision (P.B. 3, P. 2, Boone Clerk's records) and being that portion of Breezy Road of said subdivision severed off the east side thereof by the east line of Interstate Highway #75 and on which said portion of Breezy Road lots #176 to #182 inclusive front and described thus: BEGINNING at the intersection of the east line of Interstate Highway #75 with the east line of Breezy Road in the approximate center of the front of lot #176; thence running in southeast and southwest directions with a curve to the right, or west, of said Breezy Road of approximately 150' radius 385 feet or sufficient to reach the intersection of the east line of Breezy Road with the east line of said Interstate Highway in the front line of lot #182; thence with said Interstate Highway line N-6-37-57-W crossing Breezy Road a distance of 70 feet to a point in the west line of Breezy Road in the front of lot #295 of Highland Acres Subdivision; thence in a northerly direction with the west line of Breezy Road and with a curve to the west of approximately 125 feet radius a distance of 141 feet or sufficient to intersect the west line of Breezy Road in the front of lot #294; thence with said line of said Interstate Highway N-6-37-57-W 140 feet or sufficient to reach the place of beginning containing approximately 13,000 square feet.

shall be permanently closed. All rights and upkeep of this road shall by this action be removed from public responsibility.
