ROAD CLOSING - HIGHLAND ACRES SUBDIVISION

Judge Lucas declared a Public Hearing open at 6:12 P.M. to receive public comment regarding the request to close the Right of Way in Highland Acres Subdivision near Richwood, Kentucky as requested by Mr. & Mrs. John Steele and Mr. James McCarthy.

Hearing no comments from anyone present, Judge Lucas advised that no written comments have been received in his office and declared the public hearing closed at 6:18 P.M.

Commissioner Davis moved, seconded by Commissioner Meihaus, to close the Right of Way in Highland Acres Subdivision near Richwood, Kentucky as recommended by the Viewing Committee. Judge Lucas called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE. Exhibit "B"

ITEM V. PERSONNEL MATTERS

Ms. Marilyn Kruempelman, Personnel Director, presented several recommendations to the Fiscal Court.

Commissioner Patrick moved, seconded by Commissioner Meihaus, to approve the appointment of Joe Shepard to the position of Part Time Animal Control Officer at the Grade/Step of 4/A. Judge Lucas called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE.

Ms. Kruempelman advised that a job description to create a new position of Part Time Veterinarian would be on the next agenda. Mr. Collins said there needs to be clarification whether this position is for a Vet Technician or Veterinarian.

Commissioner Patrick moved, seconded by Commissioner Meihaus, to approve the recommendation of the Boone County Police Merit Board to rehire Ralph Talkington as a Boone County Police Officer at the same Grade/Pay Scale as when he left the Police Department. Mr. Talkington's date of employment will be April 1, 1992, contingent on passing a physical examination. Mr. Talkington will start new in seniority. Judge Lucas called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE.

Commissioner Meihaus moved, seconded by Commissioner Patrick, to approve the reappointment of Susan Poston to the Northern Kentucky Health District. Judge Lucas called for a vote on the motion, ALL PRESENT VOTING AYE.

NORTHERN KENTUCKY COMMUNITY ACTION COMMISSION

Judge Lucas advised that Mayor Evelyn Kaib and Scott Kimmich have resigned from the Northern Kentucky Community Action Commission and suggested that names be submitted as their replacement for discussion at the next Caucus Meeting.

FIRING RANGE - AIRPORT

Judge Lucas advised the airport will be adding a second firing range that may be utilized by the County Police Department. Commissioner Meihaus requested that a letter of appreciation be sent to the airport. Judge Lucas directed staff to follow through on this request.

If this is not clear to you please call me at 334-2200, only on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, as those are the only days I am working.

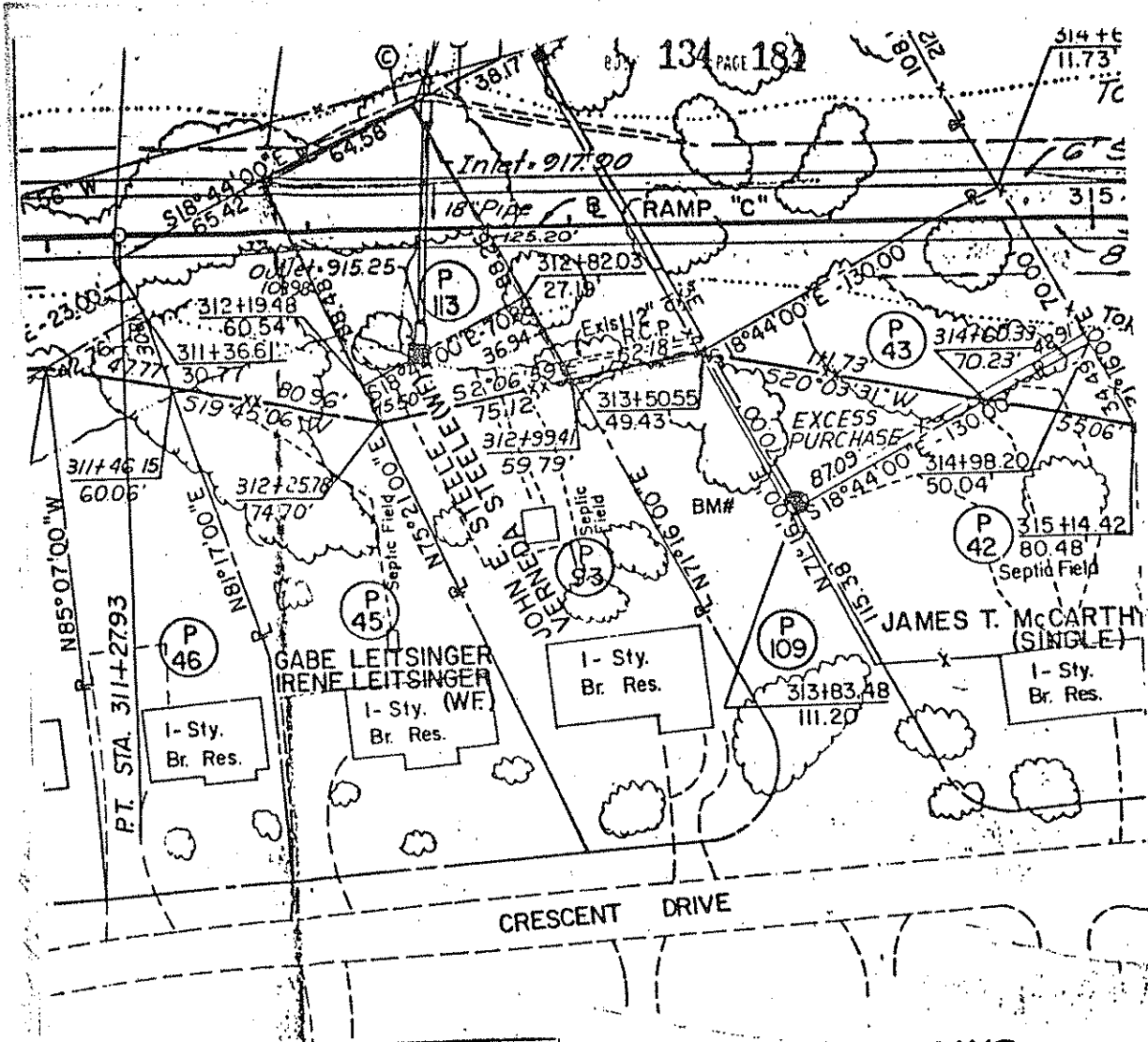
There is one item of law that states: "property adjoining area to be closed should be divided equally among property owners".
