A RESOLUTION OF THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE RIGHT-OF-WAY VACATION OF A PORTION OF LAUREL DRIVE IN HEBRON.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT:


SECTION I

That Boone County Fiscal Court hereby grants the right-of-way vacation of a portion of Laurel Drive in Hebron, Kentucky, per the following conditions:

1. The right-of-way is vacated to the adjoining parcels, all owned by the Kenton County Airport Board.
2. A conveyance plat and deed is prepared for the vacation, with utility easements granted to existing utilities within the right-of-way.
3. The Kenton County Airport Board shall be responsible for each plat and deed preparation.
4. The plat and deed shall be reviewed by the Boone County Attorney and the Boone County Engineer.
5. The Boone County Judge/Executive is authorized to sign the deed.


SECTION II

That this Resolution is hereby approved and adopted in Open Session of the Boone County Fiscal Court this 26th day of November, 2002.
