

MINUTES OF THE MEETING  
OF THE  
FISCAL COURT

The Boone County Fiscal Court was called to order by Judge Bruce Ferguson, on Tuesday, July 2, 1968, at 10:30 A.M. in the Courtroom in the Boone County Courthouse, Burlington, Kentucky.

Present: Charles Carpenter, Charles Patrick, David Houston  
and County Attorney, William P. McEvoy.

Absent: None.

Myrtle Utz, Director of the County Infirmary, presented to the Court her quarterly report. Her report was approved by the Court, all voting Aye.

Noel Walton presented to the Court, a statement for his services and a report on work done for the County during the previous fiscal year.

The Court called upon Mr. Maurer to report on bridges and roads relative to weight limits and structural soundness.

It was agreed that his completed report would be discussed and appropriate action taken at a special meeting to be held on July 9, 1968, at 7:00 P. M. at the Heritage Steak House, in Florence, Kentucky.

A delegation of persons from Sunnybrook Road and Gunpowder Road, namely: Mr. James Dameron, Mrs. Gladys Schull, Mrs. Geddis, Mrs. Russ and Mrs. Jackson, appeared before the Court to discuss the location of the bridge on Gunpowder Road that crosses Goose Creek.

The Court informed the delegation that the bridge would be completed as planned and that judgments of its location could not be adequately determined until the project is completed.

Mrs. Cecil Dickerson of Dickerson Lane requested that the County Road Department cut brush along her road which obstructs the view of the traffic. Mrs. Dickerson also requested several repairs which should be done to improve the condition of the road.

Mr. Jim Morris, County Controller, appeared before the Court to present the adjusted Budget for approval.

Motion was made and seconded, all voting Aye, to accept the adjusted Budget.

It was also duly moved and seconded, all voting Aye, to establish the County Tax Rate for the next fiscal year at 19.8¢ per \$100.00 assessed valuation on all real estate, personal property and franchise, and 19¢ per \$100.00 on Bank shares.

It was duly moved and seconded, all voting Aye, to readjust the previous fiscal year road fund budget to balance the appropriate accounts.

It was moved and seconded, all voting Aye, to direct Noel Walton to prepare necessary plans and right-of-way instruments so that the Court can receive bids for the construction of Waller Road.

Mr. Bob Barrett, Attorney at Law, presented a Resolution requesting court action to close a portion of the Limaburg Creek Road. It was moved and seconded, all voting Aye, to adopt said resolution.

Mr. Burnam Roberts, the newly appointed Building Inspector, discussed with the Court his duties of office.

It was moved and seconded, all voting Aye, that he be paid \$5,000.00 per year, and also that he be paid \$100.00 per month, expense allowance.

It was moved and seconded, all voting Aye, to pay all bills.

It was moved and seconded, all voting Aye, to adjourn until July 9, 1968, at 7:00 P.M.
