A delegation of persons from Mt. Zion Road appeared before the Court requesting that the Court take whatever action necessary so that warning lights may be installed on the Southern Railroad crossing at Mt Zion Road. The following resolution was duly moved, seconded, all voting "Aye!", and it be resolved that the Boone County Fiscal Court urgently request that the Southern Railroad System install vehicular warning lights at the road crossing of Mt. Zion Road and the Southern Railroad tracks near Devon in Boone County.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Southern Railroad operates its system through Boone County, Kentucky, and the Mt. Zion Road crosses over said railroad right-of-way which is used by the residents of Boone County, and,

WHEREAS due to the heavy vehicular traffic on said road, it is apparent to this Court that signals, which are absent from said crossing, be installed in order to avoid the loss of life or injury to persons and the destruction of personal property. This crossing, being very hazardous under normal conditions, has resulted in the recent loss of a life.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Boone County Fiscal Court does hereby respectfully request from the Southern Railroad Company to install at said crossing, sufficient safety signals in order to avoid any further loss of life.

This 4th day of June, 1968.

A representative from the Kenton County Airport Board presented to the Court a prepared document to allow the closing of a portion of Limaburg Creek Road. The Court agreed that they proceed as the law allows.

It was moved and seconded, all voting "Aye", to direct the County Attorney to proceed toward the condemnation of property of Mr. and Mrs. Jack Terrell, necessary for the reconstruction of Tanner Road.
