**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL  
COURT:**


**SECTION I**

That Boone County Fiscal Court hereby grants the right-of-way vacation of Linnoir Drive in Boone County, Kentucky, per the following conditions:


1. The right-of-way is vacated to the adjoining parcels, all currently owned by Thomas Bishoff.
2. The right-of-way is surveyed and a plat prepared. If any utility exist, there shall be a sufficient permanent easement placed over the affected area(s). The plat shall be reviewed by the County Engineer.
3. A quitclaim deed is prepared vacating the right-of-way and shall be reviewed by the County Attorney.
4. The owner of the adjoining parcels shall be responsible for the plat and deed preparation.
5. The Boone County Judge/Executive is authorized to sign the deed once completed.

**SECTION II**

That this Resolution is hereby approved and adopted in Open Session of the Boone County Fiscal Court this 5<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2001.
