

ORDINANCE NO. 0-7-68

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE PORTION OF AN ALLEY THAT RUNS IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION BETWEEN MONTGOMERY STREET IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY AND CENTER STREET IN THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY; AND AUTHORIZING, ORDERING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO INSTITUTE THE NECESSARY COURT ACTION TO HAVE SAME FOREVER CLOSED AS A PUBLIC WAY.

WHEREAS, there is a public alley running in a northwesterly direction from Montgomery Street to Center Street in the City of Florence, Kentucky, and same is not being used and has not been used for many years as a public way and has never been paved, and in such a position and location as to indicate that it will not be needed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, the owners of land adjacent to a portion thereof and on both sides thereof have petitioned this Council to take the necessary legal steps to have same closed as a public way.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the portion of an alley or public way bounded and described as follows:

A certain alley or public way being approximately 8 feet in width, the centerline of which is bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the right-of-way of Montgomery Street in the City of Florence, Kentucky; said point being S 35 - 30 W 124 feet from the southwest right-of-way of Girard Street; thence N 54 - 30 W parallel to Girard and Shelby Streets, approximately 302.5 feet or sufficient to reach the right-of-way of Center Street.

be, and the same is hereby closed as a public way of the City of Florence, Kentucky.

SECTION II

That this ordinance is passed in compliance with the provisions of the Kentucky Revised Statutes, including KRS 94.360 and that Raymond R. Vincent as City Attorney be, and he is hereby authorized, ordered and directed to institute the necessary court action in the Boone Circuit Court to have same closed.

SECTION III

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.


SECTION IV


