A RESOLUTION OF THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT AUTHORIZING THE CLOSURE AND RIGHT-OF-WAY VACATION OF A PORTION MIDDLE STREET AND VINE STREET IN TAYLORSPOINT.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT:


SECTION I

That the proposal for the closure and vacation of a portion of Middle Street and Vine Street in Taylorsport, be granted as recommended by the Viewing Committee with the following conditions:


1. The right-of-ways are vacated to the adjoining parcels.
2. The right-of-ways are surveyed with conveyance plats and deeds prepared for each portion of the vacation.
3. The owner of the adjoining parcels shall be responsible for each plat and deed preparation.
4. The plats and deeds shall be reviewed by the Boone County Attorney and the Boone County Engineer.
5. The County Judge-Executive is authorized to sign the deeds after all right-of-entries have been granted to the adjacent property owners.
6. There shall be a permanent utility easement placed over the vacated right-of-ways.

SECTION II

That this Resolution is hereby approved and adopted in Open Session of the Boone County Fiscal Court this 11th day of May, 1999.
