ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER:

A Regular Meeting of the Boone County Fiscal Court was called to order on Tuesday, December 3, 1985, at 3:07 P.M., by Judge Terry Roberts, County Judge/Executive, in the Fiscal Courtroom, Administration Building, Burlington, Kentucky. Judge Roberts gave the Invocation and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Judge Roberts introduced the members of the Fiscal Court and briefed the Agenda items to be addressed during this meeting.

ITEM 2. MINUTES:

Judge Roberts presented the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held 11/05/85. A motion was made by Irene Patrick, seconded by John Weaver, to approve the Minutes as submitted. There being no discussion, Judge Roberts called for a vote. Patrick voted AYE, Weaver voted AYE, Robinson was ABSENT, and Roberts voted AYE. The motion passed.

Judge Roberts presented the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held 11/19/85. A motion was made by Irene Patrick, seconded by John Weaver, to approve the Minutes as submitted. There being no discussion, Judge Roberts called for a vote. Patrick voted AYE, Weaver voted AYE, Robinson was ABSENT, and Roberts voted AYE. The motion passed.

ITEM 3. DELEGATIONS:PUBLIC HEARING - Sycamore Street partial road closure

Judge Roberts called to order a Public Hearing, at 3:08 P.M., and acknowledged advertising for the calling of same, relative to closing a portion of Sycamore Street, a platted street in the town of Belleview, Ky., as shown in Order Book "L", Page (82) of the Boone County Clerk's records, Burlington. Judge Roberts advised that no written and/or oral comments had been received in the Office of the County Judge/Executive. Judge Roberts presented the Viewers Committee Report as accepted by the Court on 11/19/85. (See Minutes of 11/19/85 - Exhibit #8.) Judge Roberts confirmed there to be no one present in the audience of the Court to present written and/or oral comment. Judge Roberts closed this Public Hearing at 3:10 P.M. and recommended the partial road closure request based upon the Viewers Committee Report. A motion was made by John Weaver, seconded by Irene Patrick, to close a portion of Sycamore Street, a platted street, Belleview, Kentucky, being a fifty foot right-of-way, with the County of Boone to retain the rights to construct, maintain and repair utilities over, along and through said right-of-way at such times as these services are available, and that the Boone County Board of Education and property owners, William Moore and Harry Moore, be invoiced for the associated costs of said road closure. There being no discussion, Judge Roberts called for a vote. Weaver voted AYE, Patrick voted AYE, Robinson was ABSENT, and Roberts voted AYE. The motion passed.
