A RESOLUTION OF THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT APPROVING THE RIGHT-OF-WAY VACATION OF THE WEST END OF JEFFERSON STREET (TEMPERATE STREET) IN BURLINGTON, KENTUCKY AS RECOMMENDED BY THE VIEWING COMMITTEE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOONE COUNTY FISCAL COURT:

SECTION I


That Boone County Fiscal Court hereby grants the right-of-way vacation of the West end of Jefferson Street (Temperate Street) in Burlington, Kentucky per the following conditions. A Memorandum is attached hereto as Exhibit "1".

1. The right-of-way shall be vacated to the adjoining parcels.
2. The right-of-way shall be surveyed with conveyance plats and deeds prepared for each portion of the vacation.
3. There shall be a permanent utility easement placed over the vacated right-of-way, unless releases are obtained from all applicable utility companies.
4. The owners of the adjoining parcels shall be responsible for each plat and deed preparation.
5. The plats and deeds shall be reviewed by the County Attorney and the Boone County Engineer.


SECTION II
