ITEM 1. CALL TO ORDER:

A Regular Meeting of the Boone County Fiscal Court was called to order by Judge Terry Roberts on Tuesday, June 5, 1984 at 3:19 P.M., Fiscal Courtroom, Administration Building, Burlington, Kentucky. Commissioner Weaver gave the Invocation. Judge Roberts led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ITEM 2. MINUTES:

Judge Roberts presented the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held 05/08/84, recessed and reconvened 05/10/84, recessed and reconvened 05/15/84, recessed and reconvened 05/21/84. A motion was made by John Weaver, seconded by Ronald Robinson, to approve the Minutes as submitted. There being no discussion, Judge Roberts called for a vote. John Weaver voted AYE, Ronald Robinson voted AYE, Irene Patrick voted AYE, and Judge Roberts voted AYE. The motion passed unanimously.

Judge Roberts presented the Minutes of the Regular Meeting held 05/22/84. A motion was made by Irene Patrick, seconded by Ronald Robinson, to approve the Minutes as submitted. There being no discussion, Judge Roberts called for a vote. Irene Patrick voted AYE, Ronald Robinson voted AYE, John Weaver voted AYE, and Judge Roberts voted AYE. The motion passed unanimously.

ITEM 3. DELEGATIONS:

PUBLIC HEARING re: Winston Pass

Judge Roberts called to order a Public Hearing relative to a request for closing Winston Pass, at 3:26 P.M.; and, acknowledged advertising as published for said Public Hearing. Judge Roberts advised the Court that no correspondence had been received opposing the closing of Winston Pass, confirmed there to be no one present in the audience of this Court opposing the closing of Winston Pass, and confirmed there were no additional comments from the Court members. Judge Roberts closed this Public Hearing at 3:29 P.M. A motion was made by Irene Patrick, seconded by John Weaver, to close Winston Pass as requested by residents of Booneland Trail which is a platted fifty (50) foot right-of-way of eight hundred (800) feet in length leading southeastwardly off Mineola Pike to its intersection with Booneland Trail and is shown on a plat of Bel-Air Acres Subdivision, Plat Book (3), Page (1), general reference group (#2022) of the Boone County Clerk's records with the provision that the County of Boone retain the rights to construct, maintain and repair utilities over, along and through said right-of-way at such times as these services are available as recommended within the Viewers' Committee Report submitted and approved by the Fiscal Court at the meeting of the Court held 05/08/84. There being no discussion, Judge Roberts called for a vote. Irene Patrick voted AYE, John Weaver voted AYE, Ronald Robinson voted AYE, and Judge Roberts voted AYE. The motion passed unanimously. Judge Roberts advised that the costs for said closing would be sent to the residents which included cost for the Viewers Committee and legal advertising.

Judge Roberts recognized Trudy Heider and other residents of Miller-Owens Road who appeared before the Court requesting road repair consideration. Judge Roberts recognized open discussion of the Court relative to Miller-Owens Road and the portion of said road considered to be part of the County Road Maintenance System.
